Steeped in Māori culture, history and tradition, Whakarewarewa showcases an envious way of life that has changed little in hundreds of years. At our home you can experience the sweet sound of our resident Māori cultural performance group, Te Pakira, at their twice daily concerts (three times in summer), including of course, the world-famous haka.



An abundance of geothermal activity – In our backyard, we have bubbling mud pools, boiling waters and erupting geysers. There's see Põhutu geyser, the largest active geyser in the southern hemisphere, she erupts once or twice every hour and sometimes reaches heights of 30 metres (100 feet). Põhutu means 'constant splashing' in Māori. Other notable geysers include Prince Of Wales Feathers and Kereru.

One of New Zealand's most iconic destinations, Whakarewarewa - The Living Māori Village, is both a home, as well as a whanau (family) owned and operated tourist attraction.

Whakarewarewa, an authentic, real life, Māori village, is located in Te Whakarewarewa Valley on an active geothermal plateau. We offer an unforgettable day-time Māori cultural and geothermal experience for all ages, including the opportunity to see Põhutu geyser, the largest active geyser in the southern hemisphere.

The Tūhourangi Ngāti Wāhiao people, who proudly call Whakarewarewa Village home, have been welcoming and sharing their enviable way of life, as well as history and heritage, with visitors, dignitaries and royalty for over 100 years. This includes visits from Queen Elizabeth II and Prince Phillip, as well as Eleanor Roosevelt, the US First Lady.

Today, Whakarewarewa Village is home to over 20 families who are fourth to fifth generation villagers. Daily life for the villagers is fascinating: There's utilizing the geothermal pools and steam vents for cooking; Homes are heated by geothermal activity and then there's communal bathing in the geothermal waters. The village's resident baths provides a therapeutic and

Kai – Meals and add-on catering options

Our Geothermal Experience includes all the components of the Cultural Experience with the addition of either a full Hangi Meal or a Hangi Pie.

Hangi is a Traditional New Zealand Māori method of cooking food, either cooked buried in the ground with hot rocks or, cooked above ground.

Here at Whakarewarewa, our Hangi is cooked courtesy of the geothermal steam vents: Mother Nature provides us with a wonderful natural cooking heat source.

Our two Hangi options are:

Geothermal Hangi Meal

- Chicken, beef, potato, kumara, bread stuffing, carrots, cabbage and sweet corn topped with gravy
- Dessert is our famous steam pudding, fruit salad, custard and cream
- Water, tea or coffee

Or:

Exclusive Hangi Pie Meal

- Hangi food wrapped in crispy golden baked pastry served with fresh salad and sweet corn
- Dessert is our famous steam pudding, fruit salad, custard and cream
- Water, tea or coffee

Weaving Lessons

Learn about the process of this traditional craft and how it has developed over time. Weaving is a treasured part of Māori custom and culture dating back to when Māori first arrived in Aotearoa. Create your own treasure to take as a memento of your time at Whakarewarewa.

Allow up to 90 minutes for a weaving lesson – pre booking is essential.

Poi Making

Interact with our expert poi makers and learn the art and tricks of poi making. Here you will create your own miniature poi pendant to take home with you, along with poi making skills to dazzle your friends.

Allow up to 90 minutes – minimum of 2 people max 10.

Kapa Haka Lesson

Learn to dance with the best of them! Kapa Haka means to form a line (Kapa) and dance (Haka). With the guidance of our resident cultural performers, learn to twirl a poi to a local dancing tune, or learn the fierce and famous haka.

Allow up to 90 minutes – minimum of 2 people max 10.

Marae Stay

Our overnight Marae Stay Experience is the ultimate immersive Māori cultural experience. Here, authenticity is at the heart of everything we do and you'll leave your Marae Stay Experience feeling like you've had an unprecedented insight into Māori culture and traditions.

With one night's accommodation provided in an authentic carved sleeping house, with a delicious hangi feast for dinner and continental breakfast provided, you'll have the opportunity to engage with the local people and learn in depth about Māori culture and customs. There's an interactive element too involving a traditional whakatau (welcome), Maori greeting (hongi) as well as a hands-on element with performing arts: Learn the art of poi and Maori cultural performance.

This once in a lifetime opportunity is perfectly suited for groups of 10 to 50 or more (minimum of 10 people).
